The Three-year Regional Plan of Green Public Procurement 2022 – 2024

GPP is a process whereby public authorities seek to procure goods, services and works with a reduced environmental impact throughout their life-cycle when compared to goods, services and works with the same primary function that would otherwise be procured (Buying green! - A handbook on green public procurement 3rd Edition- European Commission 2016)

In Italy GPP is mandatory under the Public Contracts Code (adopted in the 2016 and updated in the recent months)

the compliance is linked to

CAM – minimum environmental criteria inclusion in public tenders that covers many categories of public purchases

The **Liguria Region** is a western region of Italy, engaged in GPP policies for a long time (a pilot area in Enhance project) as always been active on the issue of Green Purchases:

2007 (GPP was still a voluntary instrument)

 policy that provided for the inclusion of environmental criteria in public tenders;



2016 (new Code of Public Contracts – obligation to Minimum Environmental Criteria)

- first three-year regional GPP 2017-2019 Plan
- 2021 (ONU Agenda 2030 in 2015, SSvRS in 2020) (actually in force)
- new Three-year Regional GPP 2022-2024 Plan :











GREEN PUBIC PROCUREMENT



GPP generates a significant impact on production and consumption and looking at all stages of the life cycle of products and services, becomes a **monitoring indicator for the circular economy**.

In turn, the circular economy is central to **sustainable development**, combining economic, social, and environmental needs:

Liguria Region has drawn up its own new plan fully aware of this inter-connection, proposing goals and actions which integrated with circular economy and sustainable development.



The new GPP plan represents an implementation tool of the Regional Sustainable Development Strategy, and it is transversal to other programmatic and strategic documents such the Climate Change Regional Strategy.
