Birth of the Extended Producers Responsibility (ERP)

- EPR's principle born in french law in 1975
- Applied first in 1992 in the houselhold packaging sector
- Recognized in the 2008 European Waste Frame work Directive

According to this principle, people who put on the market can ben responsable for ensuring the managment of waste from theses end-of-life products

Directive 2008/98/EC

In order to strengthen the re-use and the prevention, recycling and other recovery of waste, Member States may take legislative or non legislative measures to ensure that any natural or legal person who professionally develops, manufactures, processes, treats, sells or imports products (producer of the product) has extended producer Responsibility.



Birth of the Extended Producers Responsibility (ERP)

Article L541-10 du Code de l'Environnement

«In accordance with the principle of extended producer responsibility, any natural or legal person who develops, manufactures, handles, processes, sells or imports products that generate waste or elements and materials used in them may be required manufacturing, [...], to provide or contribute to the prevention and 150 – management of waste derived from it (...).

Producers fulfil their obligation by setting up collectively **certified eco-organizations**, **governing them and transferring their obligation** to them and making a financial contribution



Principe

EU

Art. L. 541-10-1 du Code de l'environnement : Loi AGEC

Construction products or materials of the construction sector intended for households or professionals, as of 1 January 2022, so that the construction or demolition waste resulting therefrom is recovered free of charge when it is the subject of a separate collection and so that traceability of that waste is ensured. A decree in the Council of State defines the procedures for the application of this 4° as well as the minimum conditions of the mesh of the recovery points

To take on the extended producer responsibility (ERP), we need government approval (2023 – 2027)

- A response to specifications established by the government
- Submission of the file on 22nd July 2022
- Series of questions and auditions
- Hearing of a committee issuing an opinion (22nd September)
- The government approval : 30th September 2023

Birth of the Extended Producers Responsibility (ERP)

- For each producer, 2023 eco-contributions are due to Valobat after signing a contract online
- The rates are published on our website : https://www.valobat.fr/barememoteur-de-recherche/
- The process
 - An annual declaration of tonnages (+ a simplified declaration for the smallest producers)
 - Payment: 4 quarterly installments (1 annual payment for the simplified declaration)
- The Valobat's services to assist future members in EPR
 - Support with an extensive back-office team
 - Numerous online tools : online simulator, members' guide, tutorials, FAQ, etc.



3. What happens for building waste holders?





At 1rt January 2023, free recovery of waste from construction sites

- The waste construction or renovation holders (what ever the size)?
 - Individuals
 - Craftmen
 - General construction company
- At fisrt january, Building waste holders can deposit their waste at deposit points free of charge when sorted
- Where are the deposit points?
 - Public waste collection centers
 - Private and professionnal waste collection centers
 - General or specialised distributors
 - Warehouses of construction companies (for example, joinery or general companies, etc.)
 - Directly on construction sites when waste production exceeds 50m3
