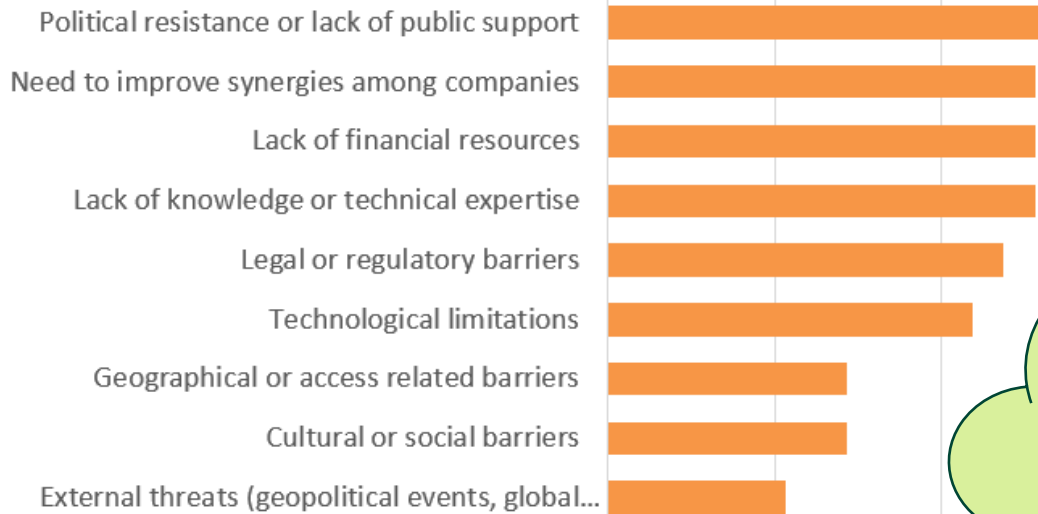

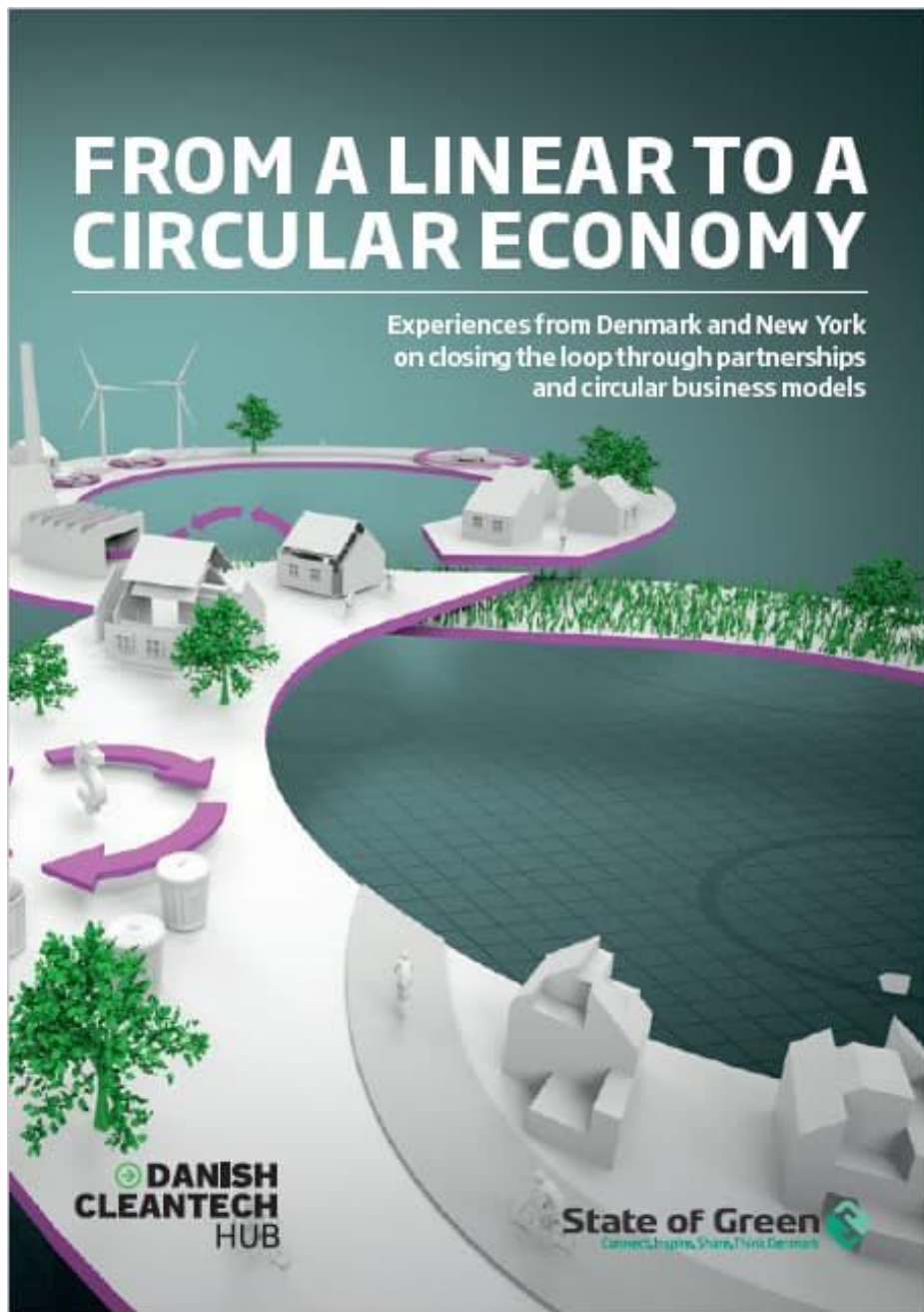

Industrial Hemp – growing the rawmaterials

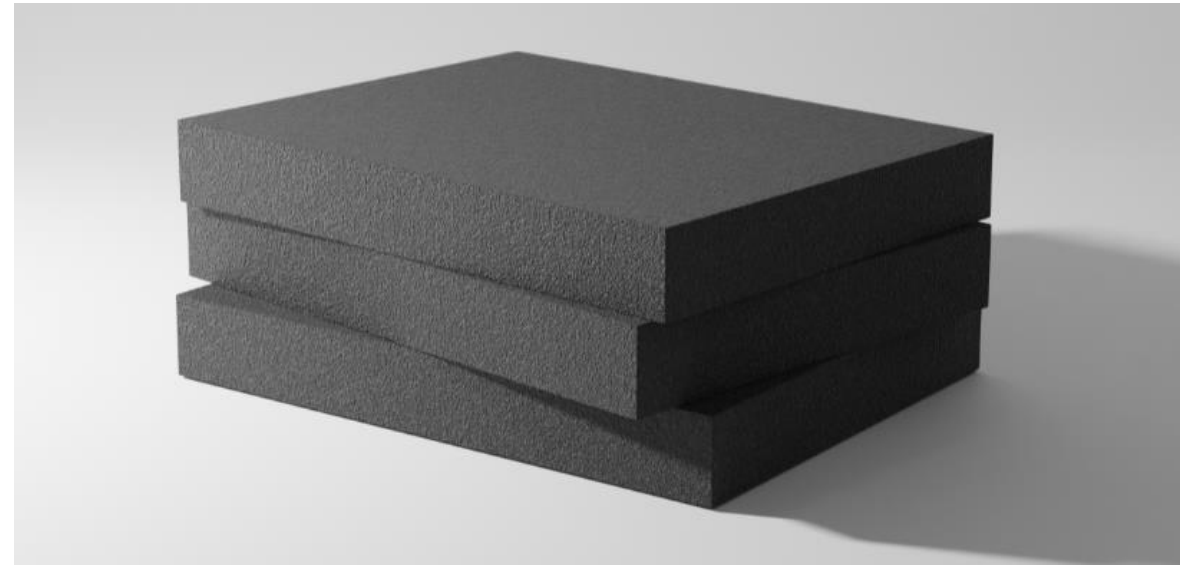

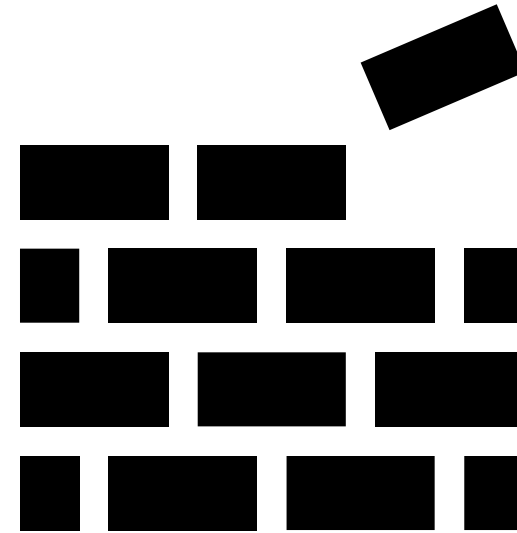
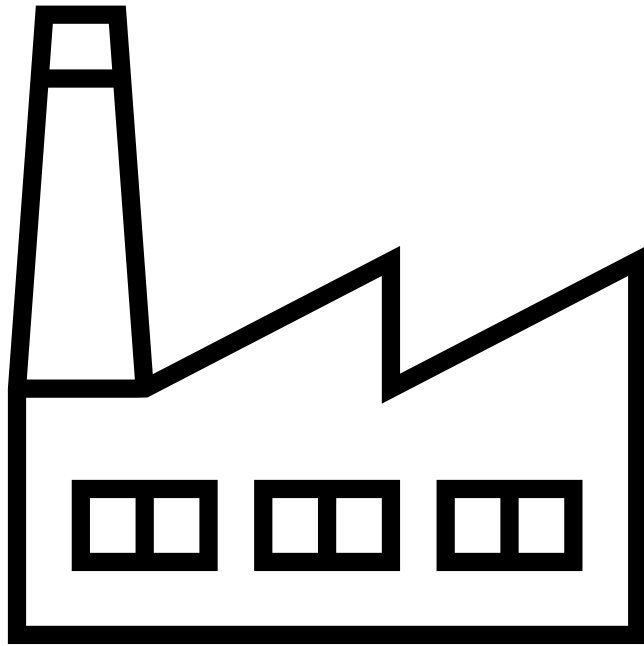
The danish approach in INERTWASTE
