Main challenge: Financial autonomy



PP06 - WEST ROMANIA REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY



EDIH directly managed by the West Regional Development Agency, including service delivery process.

Digital Maturity Assessment

- Industry approach: Manufacturing, Agrifood, Health, Construction and HORECA.
- Access to EDIH services based on public call.
- National Grant covers 50% of the cofinancing.
- 105 digitization projects (80 SMEs + 25 LPA).
- Not (yet) a segmented appoach towards the public administration → Planned.

BEST DIH Conclusions

- (E) DIHs are an important tool to provide tailormade digital solutions to SMEs and public sector organisation.
- (E) DIHs are not at the same level of services provision to public administrations.
- 5 out of the 7 (E) DIHs include Public Administration as a potential "client".
- Not an specific approach for public administrations, at the same level of SMEs.
