

## Where We Are Now: This Semester's Activities

#### Study Visit in Harghita County, Romania

The **SECON** project partners gathered in Harghita County, Romania, from April 16-18, 2024, for a productive international partner meeting. The visit featured thematic seminars and coordination meetings, focusing on fostering an enabling environment for the social economy. Participants explored exemplary social economy initiatives during good practices visit tours to the Civitas Foundation, Helyénvaló Local Products Shop, and KÖZ. community coffee shop in the Odorhei region, as well as the Workshop of Harghita County Association of Disabled People and Jakab Antal Study House of the Caritas Social Association in the Miercurea Ciuc region.



The event also included **cultural experiences** such as local gastronomy presentations and folk music and dance performances, enriching participants' understanding of the region's social and cultural context. This visit was instrumental in enhancing interregional cooperation and sharing valuable insights into social economy practices.
