





From 24 February 2022 to 30 June 2024, 8.134.244 Ukrainian citizens entered the territory of Romania, among whom: 4.492 individuals requested asylum, 182 individuals obtained a form of international protection and 162.256 individuals received temporary protection.





1587 Ukrainian refugees are registered at the Maramureş County Employment Agency (A.J.O.F.M. Maramureş)



#### Identified problem:

The majority of Ukrainian citizens are "overqualified" in the sense that, in order to practice their professions, they need the recognition of diplomas and implicitly a good knowledge of the Romanian language

#### Solution:

Providing support to people who have qualifications in professions regulated by Romanian legislation, such as: doctor, dentist, pharmacist, medical assistant, midwife, architecture, lawyer, psychologist, veterinary doctor, etc.
