- Insufficient Apprenticeship and Vocational Training Opportunities.

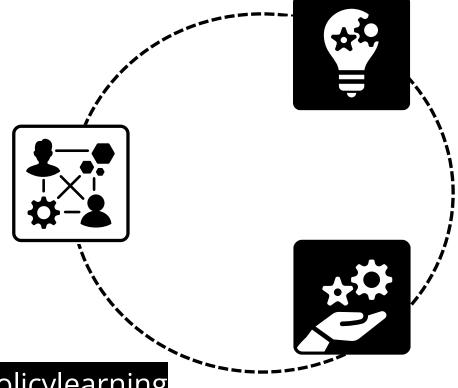
### Why a webinar on this topic?
