Lille, with a population of 234,000 inhabitants, is a medium-sized city located in the north of France and the centre of a dynamic metropolis of over 1 million inhabitants. For this reason, it faces sizeable commuting traffic, with 200,000 vehicles entering and leaving the city every day, which adds to the supply flows directed towards the city, its inhabitants, and shops. Lille is also located on the axis between Paris and the ports of the Netherlands and Belgium, and many goods transits through our territory. The city is also extremely flat (with a 10-meter difference between its highest and lowest points) and dense (inner Lille is basically a triangle, 4 kilometers long on each side), so the context is favorable for the development of cyclo-logistics.

The role in SPOTLOG

Lille shares with the SPOTLOG partners the different actions the city initiates as part of its involvement in different national projects. Especially, Lille brings to the table the insights drawn from the creation of the “*Club de la logistique*” that gathers national and regional logistics stakeholders as well as local authorities. This initiative is supported by both the SPOTLOG project and the InterLUD+ national programme.

The importance of being part of SPOTLOG

As one of the partners of the project, Lille takes part in the gatherings of the project partners that fuel the peer learning process at the core of Interreg Europe Programme. Lille participation in SPOTLOG allows the team to learn from other European partners. These learnings will inform the elaboration of Lille sustainable urban logistics action plan which will be published at the end of the project.
