# Kick-off Meeting in Bobigny, France



The YESVolunteer project, funded by INTERREG Europe, officially launched on June 18-20, 2024, in Bobigny, France. Representatives from 7 European regions explored the existing policy instruments

and programs supporting volunteering, with a particular focus on the common challenges faced by young people in each partner country.

A **study visit** showcased Montreuil Municipality's **youth-focused initiatives**, mobility schemes, and engagement strategies.

# **2nd Interregional Study Visit** in Genoa, Italy

From **December 2-5**, **2024**, Genoa hosted the **second study visit**, bringing together local authorities, youth organisations, and volunteers to **exchange experiences** and strengthen **volunteer engagement**. Key discussions have made it possible to deepen the **financial opportunities to support European mobility** (such as Erasmus+, European Solidarity Corps and ALMA project), and to discuss necessary actions, like reducing **bureaucratic barriers**, and fostering **long-term partnerships** with youth organisations.

### 3rd Interregional Meeting & Study Visit in Kielce, Poland

On March 11-12, 2025, the project held its third interregional meeting in Kielce, Poland, focusing on strategies to improve youth volunteering by including young people who are not in education, employment or in training (NEET). Delegates explored key initiatives supporting young people, including site visits to the Regional Volunteer Centre, Caritas Kielce, and the Polish Red Cross. Discussions highlighted the role of volunteering in bridging employment gaps for NEETs and enhancing their personal and professional growth.

# **Regional Stakeholder Group Meetings – Key Results**

During the **third semester**, partners held **regional stakeholder group meetings** to discuss youth volunteering challenges and solutions. Partners identified **barriers to youth volunteering**, such as **lack of awareness, economic challenges, and limited access to support services**. Proposed solutions include **mentorship programs**, **improved outreach**, **and partnerships with civic services**. These findings were presented during the **Kielce meeting** and will be detailed and **published in an upcoming report —stay tuned!**
