





Peer review: S3 strategy to unlock full potential for growth

Västernorrland Region, Sweden

Peers from: Netherlands, Belgium, Italy, Finland, Germany

Recommendations:

- Strengthening governance should enhance coordination, mandate key actors, and foster cross-regional collaboration.
- Optimizing funding should use ERDF flexibly, explore EU funding like Horizon and Interreg, and set up a regional project office.
- Boosting SME growth and green transition should develop clusters, expand advanced manufacturing, and leverage renewable energy strengths.
- Positioning as an innovation hub should drive collaboration, maximize renewable energy, and align with Sweden's and Europe's priorities.



- Hydrogen Valleys scale up the hydrogen economy by integrating production, distribution, and use
 in regional ecosystems. They drive regional innovation, economic growth, and support EU cohesion
 through interregional cooperation.



How to advance hydrogen valleys in Europe?

Latvija

CUnited Kingdom

Encourage regions to align their Hydrogen Valley initiatives with EU policies and objectives (GreenDeal, REPowerEU...)

Raise awareness and build capacity among regional stakeholders to tap into EU funding sources such as Horizon Europe, I3, Innovation Fund, Connecting Europe Facility, Just Transition, NZAV...

Promote partnerships among industry, research, and public authorities... EU energy sovereignty issues

Rarcelona

Develop hydrogen infrastructure (e.g. refuelling stations, pipelines) and support training programmes to build a skilled workforce ready for the hydrogen economy.
