



How to arrive

• By Plane:

The closest airport to Genova is Cristoforo Colombo Airport (GOA), located about 7 km from the city center. To reach Palazzo Doria Spinola:

- Taxi: A fixed fare of around €25–30 to the city center. Taxis are available at the arrivals area.
- Volabus Shuttle: The Volabus shuttle connects the airport to Genova Piazza Principe and Genova Brignole train stations. Tickets cost around €6 and can be bought onboard.
- Private Transfer: Private transfer services are available upon reservation through hotels or local providers.

• By Train:

Arrive at either of the main stations in Genova:

- **Genova Piazza Principe** (near the port) or **Genova Brignole** (in the city center).
- From Genova Piazza Principe Station:
 - Taxi: €10–15 depending on traffic, takes about 10 minutes.
 - Bus: Several city buses connect the station to the city center.
- From Genova Brignole Station:
 - Taxi: €5–10 depending on traffic, takes about 5 minutes.
 - Walking: It's around a 10-minute walk to Palazzo Doria Spinola.

• By Car:

Genova can be accessed via the A10 motorway (Autostrada dei Fiori), from either the west (French border) or the east (Milan).

- From the A10 motorway: Follow signs for Genova Centro and then Via Balbi or Piazza Principe.
- Parking:

There are public parking garages available near the city center (e.g., Garage Balbi, Parking Darsena). Street parking may be limited, but there are several spots around Piazza Principe and Via Balbi.
