Peer review key features

In-depth thematic exchanges over two days about a specific policy challenge in the beneficiary region or in one of the peer regions.

- Platform experts organise and facilitate the peer review
- Careful preparation of all participants (beneficiary and peers)
- Opportunity to involve stakeholders
- Onsite or online adapted agenda and format
- Costs covered by the Platform
 - Beneficiary
 Catering, interpretation, and local transport
 - Peers
 Travel and accommodation costs and Flat Daily Allowance (FDA) of EUR 350 for up to three working days (upon request)



Who can apply for a peer review?

- Public authorities responsible for regional development policies from programme eligible area (all EU, Albania, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Moldova, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Norway, Serbia, Switzerland, Ukraine)
- Priority to non-project partners

Transition towards a more digital, green, and resilient economy



Key drivers of the industrial transformation are:

Digitalization

The rise of digital technologies offers unprecedented opportunities to enhance industrial productivity and innovation. By leveraging AI, IoT, and big data, industries can improve efficiency, reduce costs, and open up new avenues for growth.

Green Transition

Sustainability is at the core of the European Green Deal, aiming to make Europe the first climate-neutral continent by 2050. Industries must adapt to stricter environmental standards and embrace circular economy principles to thrive in this green future.

Resilience and Sustainability

The recent disruptions, such as the COVID-19 pandemic and geopolitical tensions, have highlighted the need for resilient and adaptable industrial sectors. Strengthening supply chains and fostering community resilience are essential to withstand future shocks.

The new European industrial policy includes a dedicated strategy for small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) "for a sustainable and digital Europe."

"Sustainability Advisors will be appointed within the existing Enterprise Europe Network to help SMEs with environmental and social challenges and improve access to skills.

Up to 240 <u>Digital Innovation Hubs</u> will advise SMEs on how to integrate digital innovations into their products, business models and processes.

The new <u>European Innovation Council</u> (EIC) will make available €300 million as of next year to encourage breakthrough innovations delivering <u>Green Deal</u> objectives."
