- To show how this natural and cultural heritage is a key to mitigate impacts caused by Global Climate Change



How to:

- Create a set of routes that can be done by car or bicycle, with shorter "subroutes" to be done by feet or bicycle, that explain how water and groundwater interact with landscape and human settlements
- Catalog places and systematize existing information
- The information must be presented clearly, whilst incorporating modern communication techniques

- Technical staff able to coordinate the process (including the group of stakeholders) and the contents
