European Framework for reuse and repair

- **Waste Framework Directive**

- Promote reuse and repair - **accredited repair and reuse centers**
- Preparation for re-use and recycling of municipal waste will be increased to a minimum of 55 %, 60% and 65% by weight by 2025, 2030 and 2035 respectively

- **Right to repair**

- Concept announced in several EU documents
- Product obsolescence



European Framework for reuse and repair

- **Packaging and Packaging Waste Directive**
 - Reuse targets for packaging
- **Ecodesign directive**
 - Proposal for a new Ecodesign for Sustainable Products Regulation
 - Establishes a framework to set ecodesign requirements to improve their durability, reusability, repairability, etc.



Policy solutions for reuse and repair

- Policy solutions from CECI, 2LIFES, REDUCES, RETRACE, INTHERWASTE, WINPOL, SYMBI, LCA4REGIONS on
 - Reuse and repair centres and networks
 - Deposit return systems
