

#### **AWARDS**

What had begun in 1978 as a European NGO's awards scheme became in 2002 the European Union Prize for Cultural Heritage/Europa Nostra Awards.







The Awards honour every year:

- up to 30 outstanding heritage achievements
- 7 Grand Prix laureates
- 1 Public Choice Award

The Awards are given in 4 categories:

- Conservation
- Research
- Dedicated Service to Heritage by individuals or organisations
- Education, Training and Awareness-Raising





- Number of **applications** received from 2002 to 2017:
- ➤ Total: 2,720 applications from 39 countries
- Number of Award winners from 2002 to 2017:
- > Total: 455 Award winners from 34 countries
- **2018 entries**: 163 applications from 31 countries
- In the future, mobilize more cross-fertilisation!



#### **7 MOST ENDANGERED SITES 2018**










#### **7 MOST ENDANGERED SITES MAP**

#### **LOBBYING**

#### Raise the Profile of Cultural Heritage in EU Policy

2014, 2015, 2016 and 2017 were historic years for cultural heritage in Europe.

The EU Council of Culture Ministers, the European Commission, the European Parliament and the Council of Europe spent a lot of energy reflecting upon the importance of cultural heritage in EU policy.

The result is the adoption of far-reaching official documents defining cultural heritage, highlighting its role in attaining various EU objectives and delineating an integrated approach at EU level.

Social Summit of Gothenburg of 17/11/2017 also discussed value of cultural heritage, culture and education.



#### **LOBBYING**

#### Raise the Profile of Cultural Heritage in EU Policy

The European Commission's most recent proposal for a new European Agenda for Culture, with its strong focus on heritage, allows to envisage an ambitious and concrete follow-up to the European Year of Cultural Heritage with the adoption of a European Action Plan for Cultural Heritage ahead of the 2019 European elections

#### **Article 3.3 of the Lisbon Treaty (2007)**



"The Union (...) shall respect its rich cultural and linguistic diversity, and shall ensure that Europe's cultural heritage is safeguarded and enhanced."



(recital 1 of Decision establishing the European Year as adopted by the European Parliament on 27 April 2017)

« (...) to encourage the sharing and appreciation of Europe's cultural heritage as a shared resource, to raise awareness of common history and values, and to reinforce a sense of belong to a common European space. »

(Article 1 (2))

- Enrichment and deepening of symbolic meanings and aesthetic values drawn from European tradition.










## Flagship 3 5th anniversary of the 7 Most Endangered programme
