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# Advantages of municipal heritage planning

#### Overall objective:

- Improve involvement of local communities and improve understanding of heritage
- Facilitate a sustainable development of coastal areas

#### **Advantages:**

- Increases understanding and interest of heritage within public authorities
- Increases public participation



# Impact, success factors and limitations

#### Success factor:

Community involvement - strategy for mapping of knowledge within communities.

#### Impact:

- Strength social bonds within communities and across generations
- Revitalisation of awareness of cultural diversity and local distinctiveness
- Better integration of heritage in local development measures

#### Challenge with evidence-based development policies

- Highly complex evidence base
- Local involvement processes are resource demanding



### **Building preservation centres**

#### Overall objective:

- Provide guidance on restoration for individual house owners and professional craftsmen by focusing on traditional methods, practical rehabilitation and architectural styles.
- Targets the craftsman as the primary advisor for private owners

#### Impact:

- Constructive dialogue with civil society
- Legitimacy to heritage preservation policies
- Economic payback by providing support for rehabilitation grants from national funds.

#### Limitations:

Labour intense practise, face-2-face dialogue

#### Potential regions:

Cultural environments with a high % of private ownership
