2. Joint Welcome

Session facilitated by PLP team

1st Interactive discussion on 2 subtopics

(1.5 hours)

2 peers presenting their experience 10 minutes each, followed by 25 minutes discussion on possible recommendations for Barcelona

- Words of welcome by the host, and Rene Tonnisson ,Thematic Expert for SME Competitiveness of the Policy Learning Platform (5 minutes)
- Short Introduction of the participants (10 minutes)
- The state of play of Interreg Europe and the concept of the Peer Review by Interreg Europe PLP team member (10 minutes)
- Presentation of the policy challenge and the host's expectations from the peer review (30 minutes)

Presentation of the peer experiences and interactive discussion between the participants and the peers, grouped into 4 focus areas:

- Talent attraction and Retention. How to make policies to foster talent attraction without the legal tools of a State? How to foster talent retention in attractive regions like Barcelona? (45 minutes).
- 2. **Alternative financing**. How can we find foster alternative ways of financing, different than the classic ones, from the public bodies? (45 minutes).

2nd Interactive discussion on remaining 2 topics

- 3. **Start-up definition**. Which is the best way to define a start-up? Should this definition condition the access to grants, administrative simplification? (45 minutes).
- 4. **Start-up monitoring**. Is there a tool to monitor in real time all the start-ups existing in Catalonia? Could a proactive approach start-ups have to sign-up to get benefits be enough? Are there any software solutions, or database presentations, that solve this or do a better job than our current directory? (45 minutes).

Concluding the discussion and outlining next tasks for preparing the policy recommendations (15-20 minutes)

After the peer review the policy recommendations will be drafted and validated and compiled using a shared folder where the PLP Team will prepare a first draft and where all peers are invited to contribute with modifications and amendments.

4th DAY Presentation and Discussion of the Final Policy Recommendations

Presentation and discussion on policy recommendations and follow-up actions, which have been prepared by IE PLP team and validated with the peer on bilateral basis online.

Presentation of the drafted conclusions and recommendations of policy actions to the host and regional stakeholders

Discussion on how to operationalise and take up the discussed recommendations. Following the peer review meeting, the main conclusions should be translated into a proposal for concrete policy action ("to do-list" presenting the actions to be taken – document to be drafted after the peer review meeting).

Discussion on possible follow-on actions, future cooperation opportunities and next steps.
