

RIS3 Governance - Definition





Regional innovation governance - Definition

 Regional innovation governance is not only about policies but also a process that involves various actors that together determine the priorities, strategies, activities and outcomes in research and innovation.

'Governance is about handling of complexity and the management of dynamic flows. It is fundamentally about interdependence, linkages, networks, partnerships, co-evolution and mutual adjustment'.

(Book: Science, Technology and Global Governance)

Strategic and operational governance

 Strategic governance to determine priorities and operational governance to define actions to respond to those priorities.

RIS3 governance

 Governance is especially important for (1) the selection of projects for public funding (2) a continuous Entrepreneurial Discovery Process (EDP), and (3) monitoring mechanisms.
