CRE:HUB brings together eight regions that consider Cultural and Creative Industries (CCI) a strategic sector of development and want to create new enterprises and to support the existing ones working in this field.

Why is needed?

- CCIs have difficulties in access to credit and lack resources to enhance their competitiveness on the global market, build effective partnerships, extend their activity to other countries.
- CCIs represent an innovative branch of business and have the potential to increase regional competitiveness and job creation capacity.

Areas of intervention


- further development of financial instruments (diversification, new instruments)
- increase SME capacities (coworking, incubation)
- better governance (synergies of EU and regional initiatives, cooperation platform, webspace)
- clustering
- capacity building for youths
- monitoring of implemented initiatives/projects

- formal and informal network development
- incubation and mentoring
- joint project development
- scholarship
- voucher/financial scheme
- SME service provision
- thematic event



Impacts

- CCI embeddedness
 - better finance
- growing efficiency of networking
 - growing competitiveness
 - job creation
- acceleration of regional economies

Added value of interregional cooperation



- Learning from international environment (both PP and stakeholder level)
- Peer review values (involvment of foreing experts to local processes)
- Acceleration of CCI as a strategic field
- Common understanding
- Cooperation of different interest groups (BSO, authorities, private companies)
