2017

Establishment of an interdepartmental office for digitalization in the province of Lower Austria to coordinate all measures concerning digitalization

ecoplus was commissioned to develop and implement the program **House of Digitalization**

2018

Lower Austria develops its own **strategy for digitalization**

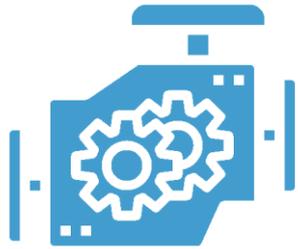

# House of Digitalization: The development



House of digitalization  
The **network.**

In **2018** an **intelligent digital network** was established. This living network is the **engine of the project.**



House of digitalization  
The **virtual house.**

In **2019**, the virtual **House of Digitalization** was established as the cross-industry, structured and online **information hub** of the project.



House of digitalization  
The **actual building.**

The real **House of Digitalization** is the last piece of the puzzle in this process and will become **the heart of the whole project.**



# Learning from Good practice

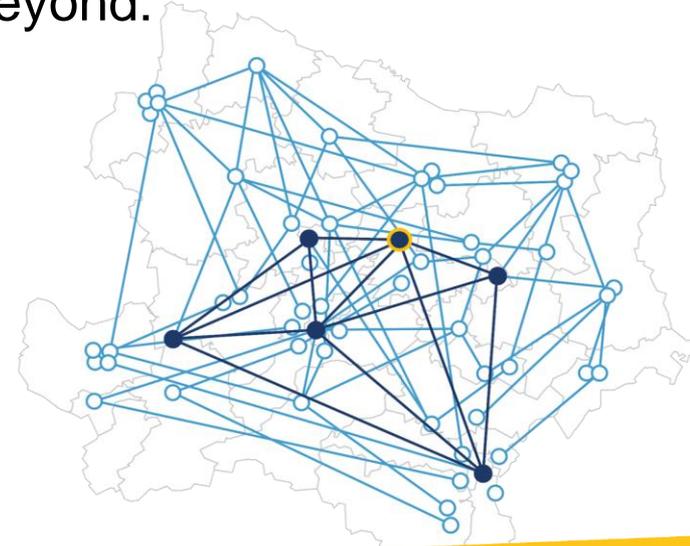
- **INKREASE:** Increase the capacities of innovation ecosystems, reinforce collaboration between research & business communities and exploit the economic valorisation processes of research results
- Good Practice from Bretagne: **CRAFT** platform for regional innovation partners
- **Virtual house of digitalisation** improvement: increased resources for facilitation / maintenance of web platform





# Sharing our Good Practice

- In ongoing projects **INNO Industry** and **Next2Met**
  
- **Success factors:**
  - Involvement of all relevant stakeholders in the Digital Innovation Ecosystem
  - Growing partnership within the region & beyond:
    - Lower Austrian lighthouse project
    - Austrian Digital Innovation Hub (DIHOST)
    - preparation of joint EDIH application
  
- **Challenges** for policy makers:
  - Incentives for cooperation needed
  - How to monitor performance and results





# Policy Improvement

- Learnings from **INNO Industry** GPs from Slovenia and Portugal
- New regional financial support scheme for digital transformation of companies launched in June 2020: **Digi4SME** - since Nov. 2020: **Digi4Business**
  - Enlarged target group incl. service sector
  - Simplified, faster application process: jury meetings every 2 weeks, official project approvals every month, application form: 2 pages only.
- **Output:** ca 1200 project applications since June 2020
- **Impact:** a lot of new companies reached, far beyond the « usual suspects »



# Recommendations for (regional) policy makers

1. Put **needs of SMEs at the centre** (not technology)
2. Incentivise cooperation of stakeholders in your Digital Innovation Ecosystem
3. Build on existing competencies within your region and connect to complementary competencies beyond
