
- Member States are advised to involve their regions in the definition of the Recovery and Resilience Plans, but no legal obligation
- Concerns remain regarding the involvement of local and regional government
  - Regions report a low-level of information and consultation
- High differentiation between member state approaches

  - How have you tried to shape your national RRP?






### Responses

- 70 projects represented in respondents






#### What flagship areas are most important for your region?






#### What flagship areas are most important for your region?

















#### How have you tried to shape your national RRP?

High involvement

- 'Have held meetings with regional government'
- 'We have drafted proposals for the responsible ministry'
- 'We're looking to creating a framework for 'small ideas' to be combined for funding' (project aggregation)
- 'Co-ordinating local stakeholders to be able to apply for funds'
- 'Project ideas are being collected from stakeholders'
- 'Very little access to decision-makers'
- 'No measures taken, not sure where to start'
