Stuttgart's Climate Action Programme

- 200 million EUR for Climate Action in 4 years
- Working across the city admin
- 3 action areas:

- Buildings, power, heat (133 MEUR)
- Mobility, food and awareness (35 MEUR)
- Adaptation to climate change (32 MEUR)

What is Stuttgart's Climate Innovation Fund?


- History in „science night“
- 10+3 million EUR for local „climate innovations“
- Project funding (grants)
 - from 25.000€ (only local applicants)
 - up to 1.000.000€ (open for any European applicant)
- Broad range of „climate innovations“
 - Focus line for nature-based solutions






Specials features – or: What do we do differently?

- Easy application, but various control mechanisms
- Results-based financing
- Learning system
- Project selection by Climate Innovation Council without city representatives





Applicants



- Education
- Large company
- SME
- start-up
- Non-profits

- 40 proposals applying for 13 million EUR
- 60% private businesses
- 10 approved projects with 2.2 million EUR
