WHAT IS CLIPPER?



CLIPPER is an innovative interregional cooperation project that brings together seven pro-active regions to address the negative impact the global economic recession has had on Europe's maritime sector. This sector is also suffering from growing competition from emerging countries. Even more so with the COVID crisis.

The overall aim of the project is to develop better policies to support the competitiveness of SMEs working in maritime industries in Europe.

To do so, the project focuses on **four levels of competitiveness**:

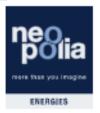

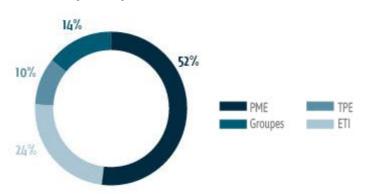

WHAT ARE THE OBJECTIVES OF NEOPOLIA

3 main objectives:

- √ To commercialise collaborative global industrial offers;
- ✓ To build a business network and strengthen the links with great market players;
- √ To support structuring industrial project development.



Federate and allow companies to work together on business issues in order to develop 5 specific industrial sectors gathered in clusters :

Aerospace/Marine renewable and offshore energies/Land mobilities/Marine/Energy









WHO AND HOW?



Integration into Neopolia and its clusters is done in two successive stages:

- 1. Join the network
 - **Eligibility criteria:**
 - To be an industrial or industry service company and to carry on an activity related to one of Neopolia's target markets
 - For companies that do not have a presence in Pays de la Loire, be integrated into one of Neopolia's five clusters
- 2. Become a member of one or more clusters
 - **Eligibility criteria:**
 - Have an activity that complements the global offer of at least one of Neopolia's five clusters

Once you are a member, you are integrated to the Neopolia business offer.

PUBLIC FUNDING







> Public funding (grants) must represent less than 50% of Neopolia's total annual budget

> 2015-18 : 2,3M€ in public funding

2019-2020 : 1,5M€ in public funding

- → Since its creation (1999), Neopolia has received 6M€ in public funding
- → Generating more than 33M€ of direct collaborative business for its members



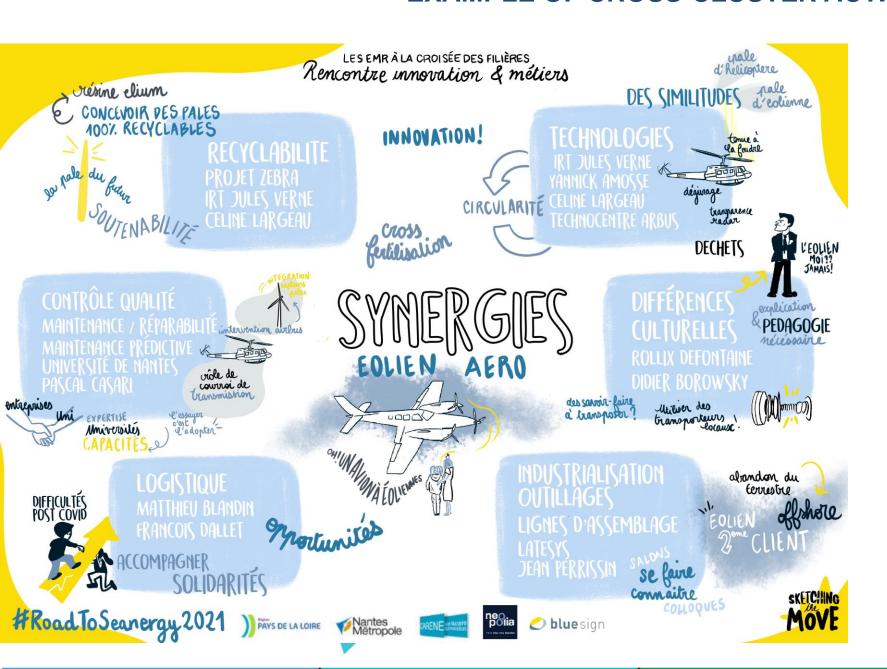




IMPACTS

- TURNOVER: 22,7M€ for 45 companies in 26 tenders (phase 7 from 2018 till 2018)
- Numerous performance indicators:
 Turnover, participations to national and international events, international representations locations, tenders' conversion rate, membership, number of members for each winning tender...
- Each business cluster evolves in a different economic context and develops its own business strategy, however the strength of the Neopolia network is also its cross-sectoral approach:
 - > Cross fertilization MRE / aerospace in the Covid-crisis context
 - > Oil&Gas cluster and Atomouest cluster were dissolved and an Energy cluster was created in 2020
 - > SAS NEOPOLIA SOLUTIONS benefits to all sector : it will carry the financial risk and present greater guarantee to potential clients

LESSONS LEARNED



After 20 years of existence, the Neopolia network is still a relevant tool:

- the 6 months long consultation organised to prepare phase 8 demonstrated that Neopolia is still an important actor and must evolves to adapt itself to new market challenges.
- the association is quite known in each business clusters field; however, it is mainly focus in Loire-Atlantique (1 of 5 counties of Pays de la Loire): one of its objectives for phase 8 is to be recognised and have more members in the rest of the region.
