What are clusters?

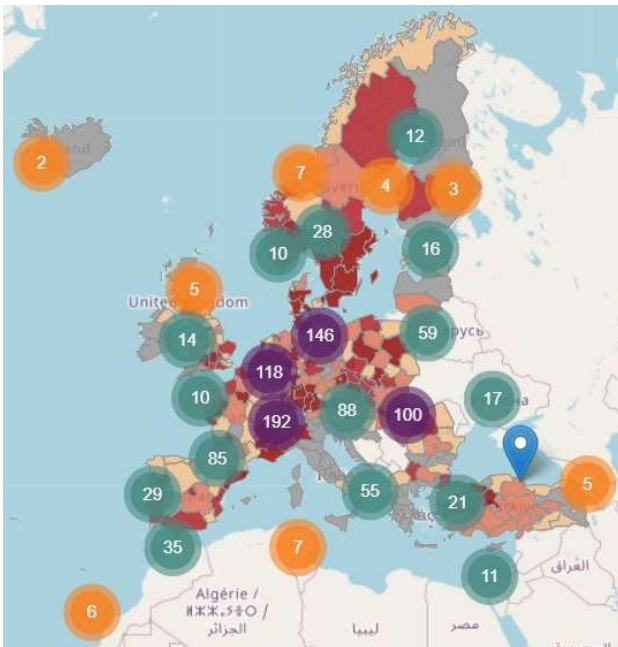
Clusters are defined as *groups of firms, related economic actors, and institutions that are located near each other and have reached a sufficient scale to develop specialized*



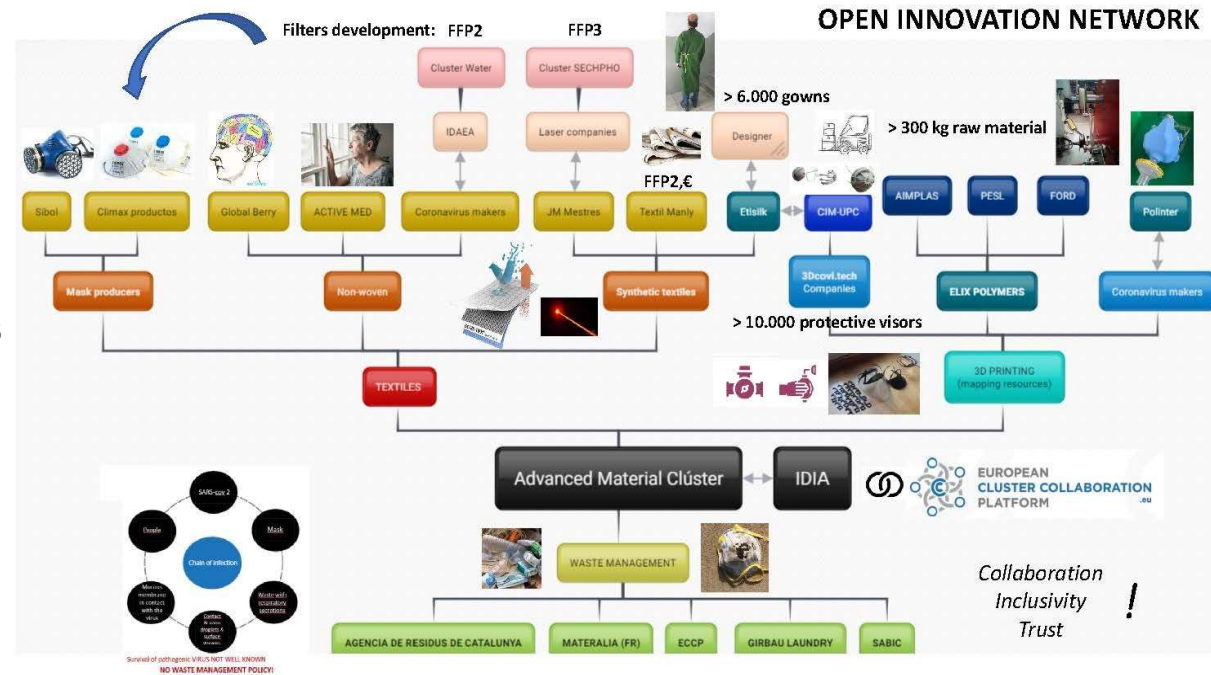

During the COVID-19 crisis, clusters have quickly adapted their activities, demonstrating their agility through **power of network and their organisational flexibility, technological capacity and market intelligence**

- ❖ Creation of new networks to increase the production of FFP2 and FFP3 masks and link 3D printings capacities between manufacturers, material suppliers and civic makers community
- ❖ **EU Rapid Alert Function:** European Clusters Alliance (ECA) detected and analysed 84 disruptions in European value and supply chains (soon published)
- ❖ Mobilising clusters members across EU in daily interactive meetings to provide solutions for identified issues and bottlenecks caused by the COVID-19

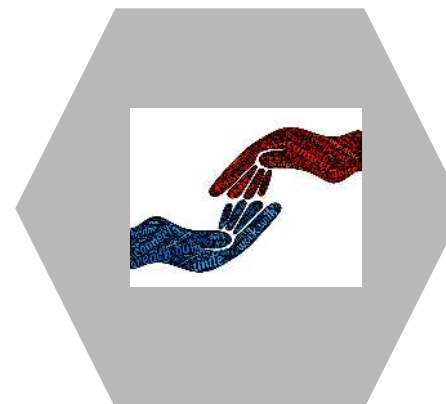

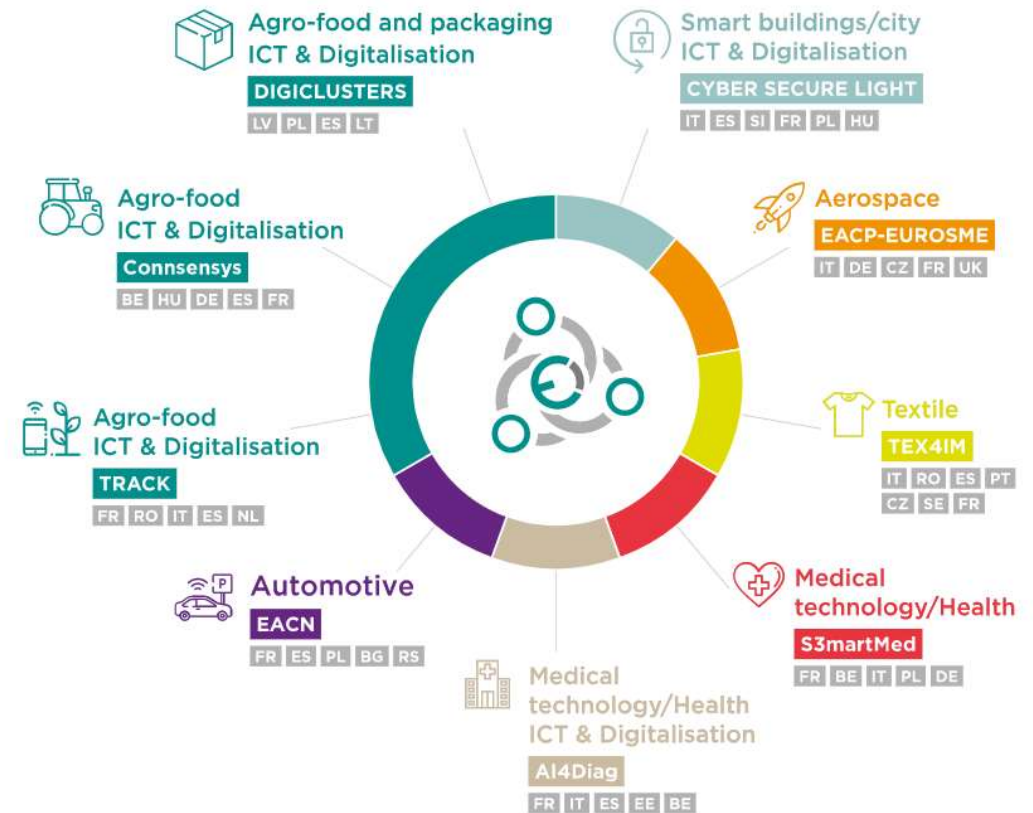

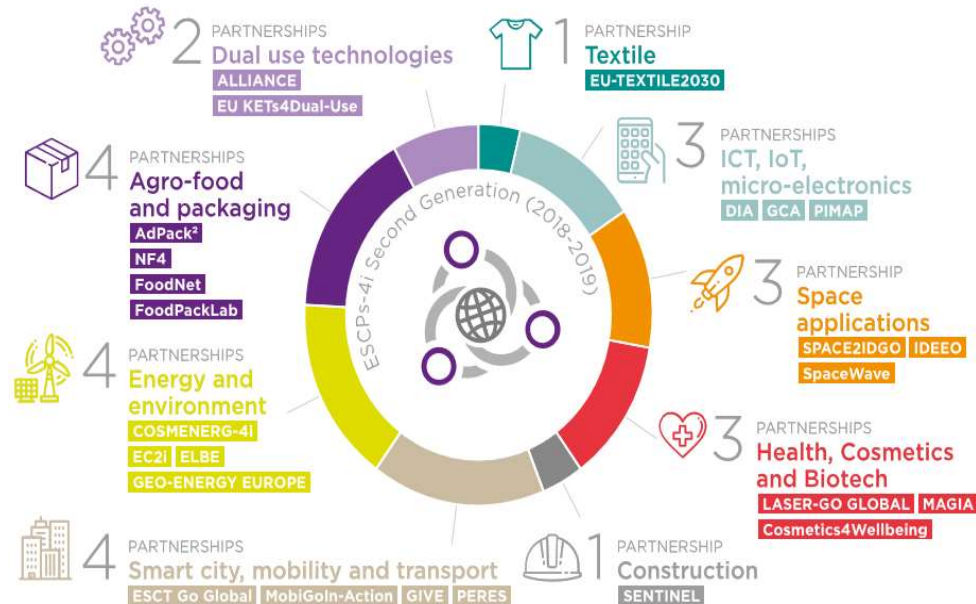

The ClusterXchange pilot scheme

Short-term exchanges:

- Identify new partners & market access
- Network & Share experiences
- Learning & training
- Technology uptake



How is it implemented?

Lump sum for visiting organisation

Matching process/ESCP-4x

Objective pilot phase:

- Overall 500 exchanges of which

50% involving **SMEs**

and at least

25% other participants beyond direct beneficiaries

Who can benefit?

- Cluster organisations (SME intermediaries)
- SMEs
- Scaling-up support organisations

(e.g. tech centres, research institutes, fab labs (digital) innovation hubs, creative hubs, resource-efficiency service providers, incubators, accelerators)

During 2015-2020, INNOSUP-1 aims to support 2,000 SMEs directly (€ 130 million)

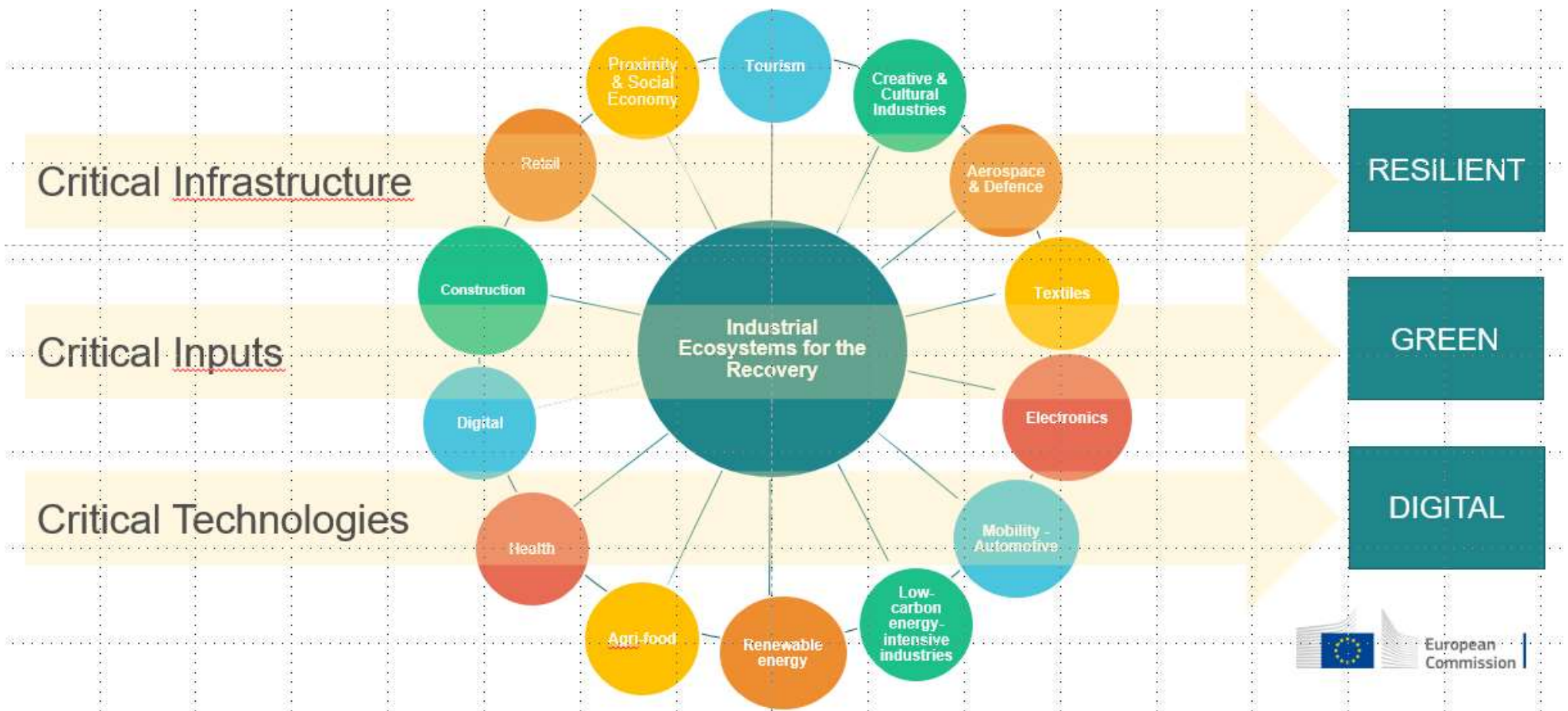
