During the COVID-19 crisis, clusters have quickly adapted their activities, demonstrating their agility through **power of network and their organisational flexibility, technological capacity and market intelligence**

- Creation of new networks to increase the production of FFP2 and FFP3 masks and link 3D printings capacities between manufacturers, material suppliers and civic makers community
- EU Rapid Alert Function: European Clusters Alliance (ECA) detected and analysed 84 disruptions in European value and supply chains (soon published)
- Mobilising clusters members across EU in daily interactive meetings to provide solutions for identified issues and bottlenecks caused by the COVID-19

Clusters Go International action (COSME)

- Facilitating European cluster to develop and implement joint internationalisation strategies, for the benefit of SMEs
- Developing common actions (i.e. business missions, cooperation agreements, gateway services, export consortia, etc.) strengthening European SMEs access to specific third markets



EU Clusters GO-International





Support common actions among clusters strengthening European SMEs access to specific third markets and initiating a long-term cooperation agenda with strategic partners in third countries

- > 6.6 M€ for all sectors <u>except</u> defence & security (12 partnerships)
- > 0.9 M€ for defence & security sector (2 partnerships)

European Strategic Cluster Partnerships for Excellence ESCP-X

Strengthen cluster management excellence & facilitate strategic connections fostering cluster capacity building & SME competitiveness, including through ClusterXchange mobility scheme, by funding partnerships

The ClusterXchange pilot scheme

Short-term exchanges:

- Identify new partners & market _ access
- Network & Share experiences
- Learning & training
- Technology uptake

How is it implemented?

Lump sum for visiting organisation

Matching process/ESCP-4x

Objective pilot phase:

- Overall 500 exchanges of which

50% involving SMEs

and at least

25% other participants beyond direct beneficiaries

(e.g. tech centres, research institutes, fab labs (digital) innovation hubs, creative hubs, resource-efficiency service providers, incubators, accelerators)



Who can benefit?

- Cluster organisations (SME intermediaries)
- SMEs
- Scaling-up support organisations

During 2015-2020, INNOSUP-1 aims to support 2,000 SMEs directly (€ 130 million)
