

Reuse and labour market programmes

- Returbutiken (reuse shop) and Textilservice (textile service) are part of a labour market programme run by Umeå municipality.
- It provides work placement for people who are outside the regular labour market.
- 10 employees and 60 placements, 80-90 participants per year

- 11 500 kg IT equipment collected •

Social value

- 10 employees and 60 placements
- 80-90 participants per year

Economic value

- 1500-2000 items sold per day
- Sales income: $0.6 \in \text{million}$ (2019)

- Requires a tight cooperation between institutions, labour market programme and the provider of products
