- Public equipment managed by the City of Lille
- Shared governance between City of Lille and Lille Metropolis (MEL)
- Aim: to help citizens of the metropolis to make their homes more comfortable and to realise energy savings

The Centre provides a whole range of services:

- Free tailored advice with professionals: phone meetings with legal experts, architects, energy advisors
- Professional guidance for energy renovation projects
- Support to apply for public subsidies
- Access to activities such as workshops, conferences, trainings, study visits

Work plan:

- How to renovate your home: advices and support regarding renovation works through self renovation workshops and general advices
- How to realise energy savings: how to decrease energy consumptions, waste recycling, improve indoor air quality
- How to act when you live in a condominum: explanations on condo taxes, maintenance fees, governance issues
- How to finance your renovation? Guidance to regional subsidies



- More than 70 000 persons contacted the MHD


