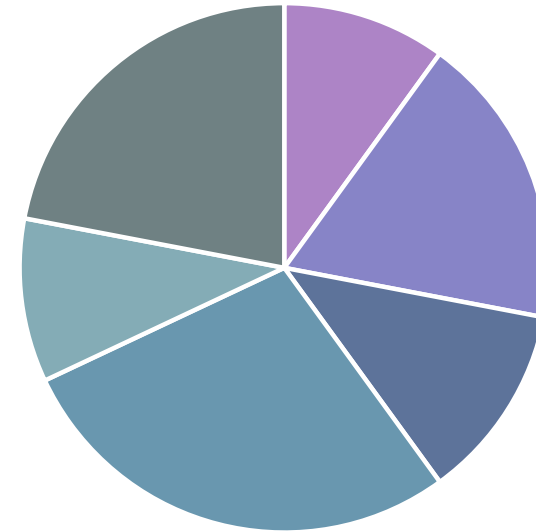

Internationalisation	22%



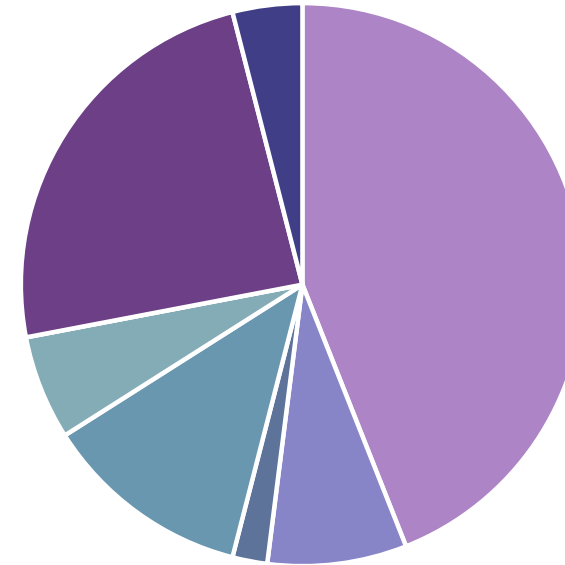

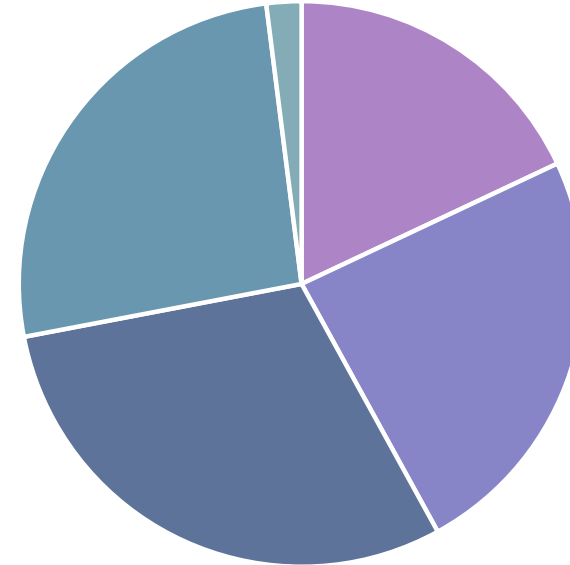

Providing benchmarking data	2%



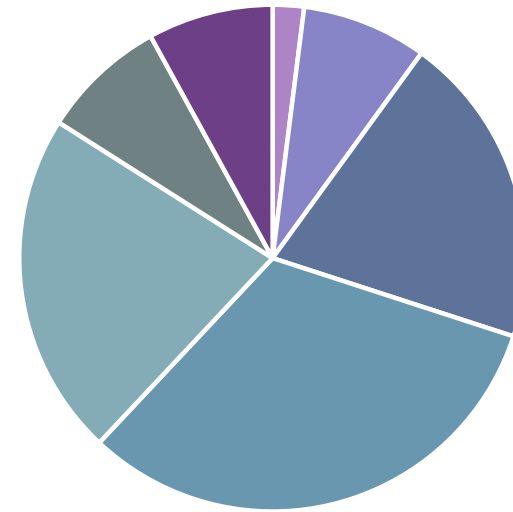
