The Basque Country

- 2.2 million population, 2 official languages, Spanish and Basque
- Regional autonomy with own government, fiscal and financial autonomy.
- Export-oriented economy, ca 30% GDP is industry-derived

Health in the Basque Country

- Basque Ministry for Health
- Basque health Service, Osakidetza (>90% provision) with 27,000 employees
- 13 Integrated Health Organisations (IHOs)



 - Priorities






Our matrix for procurement
