The advantages of PPI as a tool to achieve S3 objectives are considerable

- Allows for the government to become an active player in the innovation process: determining the challenges and areas in which the innovation takes place (can be consistent with selected pattern of specialization)
- Can simultaneously achieve several policy objectives (beyond innovation – i.e. improve public services or promote entrepreneurship) thus harnessing additional resources from other government priorities
- Has important complementarities with other tools that are commonly used in S3: instruments to foster innovation capabilities in SMEs, training to encourage innovation culture, etc.




Shared vision

- Although there is no single path to success, there are some common characteristics in PPI implementation processes that are worth taking into account when identifying how and why to incorporate them in S3


Interactions between PPI and S3 (1/3)
