### THE PROJECT

WINPOL is a European project that fosters the use of intelligent equipment and policies in municipal waste management. The project is organised in **two phases**:

- 1. Interregional learning (2018-2020):** partners identify and exchange good practices, conduct study visits and incorporate the knowledge into concrete action plans.
- 2. Implementation (2020-2022):** partners put into action the knowledge acquired and monitor and report on their results, sharing solutions with other European cities and regions.

✓ New technologies and efficient use of information (Big Data)



✓ Innovative models for waste collection, prevention and recycling



✓ Different models for waste generation fees
